UNFPA hereby solicits a quotation for:

### Distribution of Advocacy Guidelines on the Prevention of FGM/C for Health Service Providers and Young People

A set of Advocacy Guidelines on the Prevention of FGM/C for Health Sector Response (1 advocacy guideline and 1 IEC flipchart) to be distributed to addresses stated in Annex IV.

This Request for Quotation is open to all legally-constituted companies that can provide the requested services and have legal capacity to perform in the country, or through an authorized representative.

#### III. Content of quotations

Quotations should be submitted in a single e-mail whenever possible, depending on file size. Quotations must contain:

- a) Price quotation, to be submitted strictly in accordance with Price Quotation Form. The quotation must be signed by the company's relevant authority and submitted in PDF format.
- b) Annex II Bidder identification form
- c) Annex III Annex III Bidder's previous experience
- d) Annex IV Distribution list (rate and lead time)
- e) Copy of legal documents (establishment in Indonesia)

#### IV. Instructions for submission

Quotations should be prepared based on the guidelines set forth in Section III above, along with a properly filled out and signed price quotation form, are to be sent by e-mail to idn.bids@unfpa.org no later than: Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 23:59 Jakarta Time<sup>2</sup>.

Please note the following guidelines for electronic submissions:

- The following reference must be included in the email subject line: RFQ № UNFPA/IDN/RFQ/20/018 Distribution of Advocacy Guidelines on the Prevention of FGM/C. Quotations that do not contain the
  correct email subject line may be overlooked by the procurement officer and therefore not considered.
- The total e-mail size may not exceed 20 MB (including e-mail body, encoded attachments and headers).
   Where they are in large electronic files, it is recommended that these be sent separately before the deadline.

#### V. Overview of Evaluation Process

Quotations will be evaluated based on the compliance with the technical specifications (Annex IV) and the total cost of the goods (price quotation).

#### VI. Award Criteria

UNFPA shall award a Purchase Order to the lowest priced bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially compliant with the bidding documents.

#### VII. Right to Vary Requirements at Time of Award

UNFPA reserves the right at the time of award of contract to increase or decrease by up to 20% the volume of goods specified in this RFQ without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions.

#### VIII. Payment Terms

UNFPA payment terms are net 30 days upon receipt of shipping documents, invoice and other documentation required by the contract.

#### IX. Fraud and Corruption

UNFPA is committed to preventing, identifying, and addressing all acts of fraud against UNFPA, as well as against third parties involved in UNFPA activities. UNFPA's policy regarding fraud and corruption is available here: <u>Fraud Policy</u>. Submission of a proposal implies that the Bidder is aware of this policy.

Suppliers, their subsidiaries, agents, intermediaries and principals must cooperate with the UNFPA Office of Audit and Investigations Services as well as with any other oversight entity authorized by the Executive Director and with the UNFPA Ethics Advisor as and when required. Such cooperation shall include, but not be limited to, the following: access to all employees, representatives agents and assignees of the vendor; as

well as production of all documents requested, including financial records. Failure to fully cooperate with investigations will be considered sufficient grounds to allow UNFPA to repudiate and terminate the Agreement, and to debar and remove the supplier from UNFPA's list of registered suppliers.
